# **PRAYER POINTS**

## Romans 12:12

<sup>12</sup> Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

#### Philippians 4:6-7

<sup>6</sup>Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup>And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

## Matthew 7:7-8

<sup>7</sup> Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. <sup>8</sup> For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

## **Our Suffering World**

- That God will help nations deal wisely and courageously with the pandemic
- That nations will support each other as they deal with the fallout
- That those suffering without adequate medical resources may be quickly be sustained
- That leaders of integrity and wisdom will rise up
- That those who have lost loved ones will be comforted

#### The Pandemic and the Sick

- That God will 'flatten the curve'
- That God will heal those who are sick
- That God will protect the health of health care workers
- That God will provide wisdom and peace for health care workers

- That our school chaplains will be empowered in their ministry to the struggling

# The Economy and Job Losses

- That peace, hope and strength will flow to those who have lost jobs and incomes
- That God will use these economic challenges to help us rely on him
- That the economy will recover, and that jobs and confidence will be restored as the curve flattens
